

**CAMERON COUNTY IRRIGATION DISTRICT NUMBER TWO
JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

TITLE: Repair Crew Laborer

REPORTS TO: Maintenance Superintendent and Crew Leader

JOB GOAL: To work efficiently with other crew members to carry out the orders of the Maintenance Superintendent.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Install new pipelines.
2. Repair or replace broken pipelines.
3. Repair or replace broken or faulty canal gates and valves.
4. Repair, clean, and unplug pipelines.
5. Repair or replace broken or faulty canal check gates.
6. Maintain canals, canal banks, and all other District facilities.
7. Work in a safe responsible manner and always use required safety gear and equipment; goggles, gloves, back support belts, etc.
8. Perform any other duties as assigned by the Maintenance Superintendent.

ESSENTIAL PHYSICAL FUNCTIONS: Be able to perform the following functions:

1. Work in a standing position for extended periods of time.
2. Lift and carry heavy objects (from 80 up to 100 lbs.)
3. Climb standpipes, climb from excavation holes, climb canal banks and other District facilities.
4. Dig with a shovel.
5. Use a sledgehammer and pickaxe.
6. Mix and pour mortar and cement.
7. Push a loaded wheel barrel.

PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Possess and maintain a valid Texas driver's license.
2. Maintain a good driving record. (An example of a bad driving record would be;(1) D.U.I. citation, or (3) moving traffic violations or over (1) accident where you are at fault.)
