The Board of Directors of Cameron County Irrigation District #2 met in regular session in the office of the District upon the above date at 9:00 a.m.

The following Directors were present: Sam Simmons, William Goad, Buck Rhyner, and Lupe Argullin. Also present were Sonia Lambert, General Manager, and Buddy Dossett, Attorney.

There was no public comment.

A motion was made by Buck Rhyner, seconded by Lupe Argullin, and upon unanimous vote, passed to approve the minutes of the regular meetings of December 9th and the December 18th, 2021.

The water report was made by Buck Rhyner, who reported that Falcon Reservoir contains 417,516 acre-feet of water of the normal conservation 2,646,817 acre-feet. The Amistad Reservoir contains 1,104,998 acre-feet of water of the normal conservation 3,275,532 acre-feet which 36.89% is U.S. total conservation capacity compared to 48.23% this time last year. As of January 12, 2022, District's usable and storage water balances are 53,330.1622 acre-feet. This time last year, usable and storage water balances were 67,101.3015.

The Board reviewed the following subdivision plat and took the following action:

5.1) Alvarado Estates – Being a 2.77-acre tract out of a 6.51 acre tract as recorded in Volume 15583, Page 243, Official Records of Cameron County, Texas, being out of Block 153 San Benito Land and Water Company Subdivision as recorded in Volume 1, Page 6, Map Records of Cameron County, Texas. – Altex Engineering. This subdivision is located off F.M. 509. There is an existing pipeline stemming from Lateral U-1 which goes east under F.M. 509 and then south along the east side of F.M. 509 and the west side of the subdivision. The District's pipeline is not shown on the plat. The District will locate the pipeline and request an easement be reserved. No action was taken.

Mr. Geary Berkman, C.P.A., is sick and unable to present the District's 2020 fiscal year audit. This item will be placed on the February agenda.

The District's 2021 4th Quarter Investment report was reviewed by the Board of Directors. The report showed the rate for the account with First Community Bank, interest amount yielded for each month of the quarter and the ending value as of December 31, 2021. A motion was made by Buck Rhyner, seconded by Lupe Argullin, and upon unanimous vote, passed to approve the District's 4th Quarter Investment Report as presented. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Buck Rhyner, seconded by Lupe Argullin, and upon unanimous vote, passed to adopt the following resolution ordering an election be held to fill the place of two (2) directors now serving, whose terms are expiring:

May 7, 2022 Election. The motion was made and seconded that this Election Order be adopted:

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Texas Water Code and the Texas Election Code, Cameron County Irrigation District No. 2 shall hold an election on the first Saturday in May of even-numbered years, at which time the required number of Directors shall be elected to fill the vacancies then occurring on the Board of Directors as provided by law;

WHEREAS, such an election is necessary and should be held on May 7, 2022, in order that two (2) Directors may be elected to membership on the Board of Directors of Cameron County Irrigation District No. 2 to fill the place of two (2) Directors now serving whose terms of office will expire on May 13, 2022;

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined and found that in accordance with standing order of this Board, written notice of the date, place, and subject of this meeting, including consideration of the setting of said election, was posted at the District's Office at a place convenient to the public, and posted on the District's website, for the period of time and manner as is required by law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Directors of Cameron County Irrigation District No. 2 that:

- 1. A regular election for the election of two (2) Directors, each to serve for a term of four (4) years beginning May 13, 2022, be and it is hereby called and ordered to be held in and for this District, in the manner prescribed by law, on the first Saturday of May, 2022, the same being May 7, 2022.
- 2. Said election be conducted during the hours of seven o'clock (7:00) a.m. to seven o'clock (7:00) p.m. at the office of the District at 26041 F.M. 510, San Benito, Texas, a place within the District and a place which the Board, after considering the requirements of Texas Election Code § 43.031, finds to be a proper place for conducting the election.
- 3. For the purpose of said election, all the area included within the boundaries of this District shall constitute one (1) election precinct.
- 4. Said election be held at the aforesaid voting place with the use of paper ballots.
